**Contracts worth 187.7 Million Qatari Riyals on first and second day**

The Prime Minister and Minister of Interior H.E. Sheikh Abdullah bin Nasser bin Khalifa Al Thani made a tour of Milipol Qatar 2014 exhibition on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 to explore the latest products of internal security showcased by exhibitors from various countries.

## Outstanding Pavilion of Ministry of Interior

The pavilion of the Ministry of Interior is one of the largest pavilions in the Milipol Qatar 2014, about 1100 square meters in size whereas the total floor area of the exhibition is 6055 sq. m. This pavilion is included with 8 departments, which are General Directorate of Information

Systems, General Directorate of Coasts and Borders Security, National Command Centre, Al Adeid, Criminal Evidence and Information Department, Communications Department, Industrial Security Department and Community Policing Department.

Brig. Ahmad Abdullah Al Jamal, member of the Milipol Qatar Committee said that the Ministry's pavilion is an important one that participates in Milipol Qatar since its inception in 1996. The pavilion displays many of the services of the Ministry, like the services and mechanisms rendered by Information Systems Department. The Department has launched this year a new electronic system, through which marine vessels can be registered and can monitor their movements which is first of its kind in an electronic system.

He noted that the International Exhibition for internal state security this year is distinctive by the size of area and the number of exhibiting companies and we hope that it would be featured in number of contacts that would be concluded by the exhibiting companies as well. We expect the number of visitors will reach to the desired ratio. This is the first time that the exhibition works from 10 AM to 6 PM straight, to make it comfortable for the visitors.

Asst. Director of the General Directorate of Information Systems Brig. Abdul Rahman Al Maliki said that The Information Systems Department exhibits a number of projects and systems that have been applied by the department recently. The electronic systems for marine vessels which launched by HE Prime Minister and Minister of Interior was the most important one which covers the marine vessels of cruisers, boats, fishing boats and private boats. The services include registration of vessels and movement of ships during entry and exit to the ports of country in addition to the possibility of follow the

movement of these vehicles within the territorial waters of the state and watch the delayed vessels that returning to the country and take the necessary measures to follow.

He added that the pavilion also displays the new tablet system for the Traffic Department, which will be launched

soon. The Traffic officials can complete the traffic accident procedures at the scene itself with no need to transfer to the department to complete the procedures. This system will be linked through the mobile network and can finish all procedures for registration of traffic accidents and taking photos as well as produce the paper for vehicles maintenance.

Lt. Nasser Abdullah al Khalifa, the officer at Information Systems Department said

that the department is also displaying new E Gate system, which was recently installed in the Hamad International Airport, which is a device that the travelers need to merely cross it and not needed to visit the immigration counters. It is required to take advantage of this service to get data through the smart card and pay a service fee of 100 riyals per year and 150 riyals for two years and 200 riyals for three years. This

system features iris scan, and finger and face scan. The method is used by smart ID card and E-passport, where it will be placed on the device to open the first door, and the second door will be open while fingerprint is identified. This device works to facilitate the movement of passengers and ease the procedures. Abdullah Al Jaber, the Acting Director of the General Directorate of Industrial Security said that the department also takes part in the exhibition under the pavilion of the Ministry of Interior, whereas it works with the security systems concerned with oil and gas fields. He pointed that the department uses the latest security devices including the most advanced vehicle which works on satellite network, 3g and 4G also and would send the message to the national command center in a little while. Like that we have detector which can find

out all types of gas leak.

A number of official delegates and ambassadors from brotherly countries have visited the pavilion of the Industrial Security Department that proves the importance security systems in industrial sectors. The diplomatic visitors lauded the high level security services presented by the security department.

The Preventive security Department represented by Al Adeid provides communication services between the Ministry and the people. It transfers all reviews and reports of the public regarded with security, crimes and social issues to the concerned departments. Anyone in Qatar can give complaints, suggestions and queries through AlAdeid whereas it gives opportunity for all to do their role in ensuring the safety and security of the country. It is possible through SMS, fax or email round the clock.

Lt. Thamer Ali Al Kuwari of National Command Center said that the centre exhibits the programme "Najm" and the system that shows the places of patrol cars and ambulances and their movements. The service sections of the NCC are also displayed like the emergency service number 999 and the way of communicating with different departments like Al Fazaa, Traffic, Civil Defence, Coasts and Borders Security and ambulance.

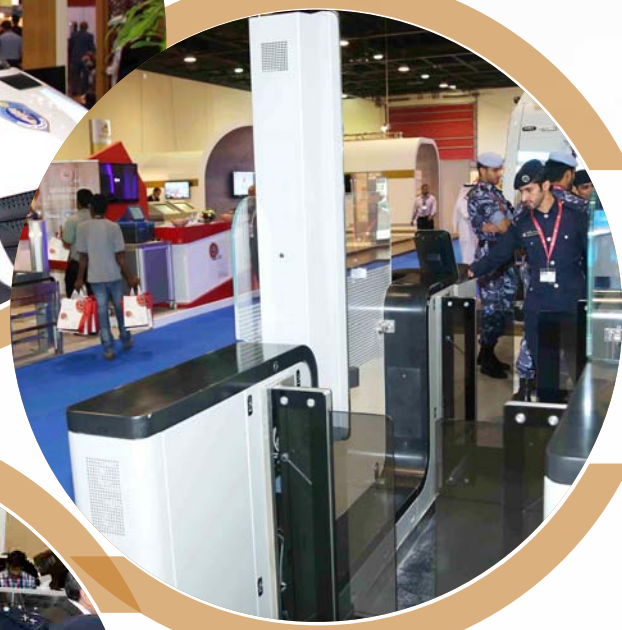
The Centre also shows the service for persons with special needs on 992. NCC also showcases the tasks of the Security Monitoring Section with the use of latest advanced systems that work in coordination with the concerned authority to follow up.

Regarding the stall of Community Policing, Lt. Ali Hassan al Mohannadi said that the department takes part in the exhibition to raise the level of awareness and education of the public and build a bridge between the public and the police through interactions and activities.

He added that the department is concerned to enlighten its vision of community partnership that would present fruitful results in ensuring security and stability for all.

## Ministry of Interior Announces Deals worth QR 187 Million

The Ministry of Interior announced deals with a number of companies participating in Milipol Qatar 2014 and total value of these contracts reached more than 187 Million Qatari Riyals.

The director of Procurement Department at General Directorate of Logistics in the Ministry of Interior and member of the Milipol Qatar Committee Brig. Saud Rashid Al Shafi announced at a press conference held at Media Centre of Exhibition that the Mol has concluded 7 contracts in the first and second day of Milipol for various Mol Departments.

Brig. Al Shafi said that the first contract was signed with AIDar Marine Company for 20 search and rescue boats for Coasts and Borders Security Dept. for an amount of 34 Million Riyals.

The second contract worth QR 61.5 Million was concluded with Al Hamad Trading Est. for 24 state of the art fire fighting vehicles and maintenance of a number of fire and rescue vehicles for the Civil Defecnce.

A third deal was concluded with Salam Technology for supply and operation of a number of security surveillance systems and programs and the contract worth QR 22.4 Million Qatari Riyals.

A Contract worth QR 16.5 Million Qatari Riyals was made with Global Enterprises Technologies (GET) to supply cards for issuing driving license and vehicle permits for General Directorate of Traffic. The fifth contract was made with Saleh Hamad Al-Mana Company and it's worth of QR 6.8 Million for supplying 114 vehicles for Mol services.

A contract worth QR36.6 Million was made with Airbus Defence and Space Company for development and maintenance of Tetra Communication System for MOI Communications Department.

Brig. Al Shafi announced that the seventh Contract worth QR 9.9 Million was made with Itqan Technologies to supply smart ID Cards for General Directorate of Nationality, Borders and Expatriate Affairs.

Brig. Saud Al Shafi hope that there would more contracts to be signed by tomorrow and the new contracts that will be announced once concluded.

The total value of these seven contracts



reached 187.7million Qatari Riyals. Responding to a question on the specifications of boats contracted with AIDar Marine, Brig. Ahmed Jamal, director of Financial Affairs Department at Ministry

of Interior said that their specifications are in line with international and local standards. The boats will be customized as per the requirements of the Coast Guard, he said.



### Various Activities at Lekhwiya Pavilion

The Internal Security Force (Lekhwiya) organized a seminar on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 where it hosted Maj. Gen. Joston Dias Da Costa, Brig. Fransisco and Col. MTJ Messers Chimdit, security and Gendarmerie chiefs from Portugal, Netherlands and Spain. Maj. Khamis Al-Miraikhi represented the Internal Security Force.

The guests highlighted the importance of training and planning in carrying out roles. of these forces.

The commander of Netherland's Gendarmerie said that it belongs to the army as well as interior ministry and it performs its policing duties with military capabilities and participate in securing the sea ports and airports. The commander of Spanish

Gendarmerie force said that it has been established since 170 years and it has undergone several developments and modernizations. The force has a centre of excellence specialized in qualifying cadets and in exchange of expertise.

The Portugal Gendarmerie commander stated that it's a semi military force and it does work in search, rescue and traffic fields.

On his part, Maj. Khamis Al-Mirakhi said that the Seminar was intended for exchange of expertise and ideas.

It's worth mention that the ISF is participating in the exhibition with biggest pavilion and it provides a nice opportunity to exhibit the latest equipment and capabilities used by the Lekhwiya.
